A resident told of an incident that happened of someone trying to force themselves into their house. The Sheriff was called. The person said he was from Ruidoso and that his girlfriend dropped him off out here.

For safety reasons:

(1) It was suggested that everyone make an effort to get to know their neighbors. (2) Keep outside lights on. (3) Several men volunteered to be on a call list if residents feel they are in danger. They will be on the neighborhood watch list. An updated list will be sent to all residents who want to be on it.

Someone asked how the cameras were working. We have good success with the current cameras in the past. But we feel we could check into updating them for more sophisticated ones. A resident said her husband does the cameras for their church and he would be willing to help research for updated cameras.

Keep an eye out because a bobcat has been cited in the neighborhood.
